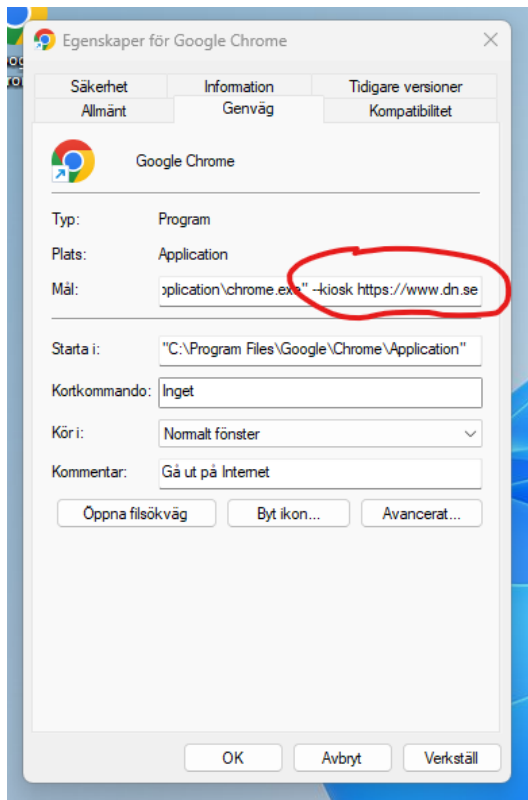
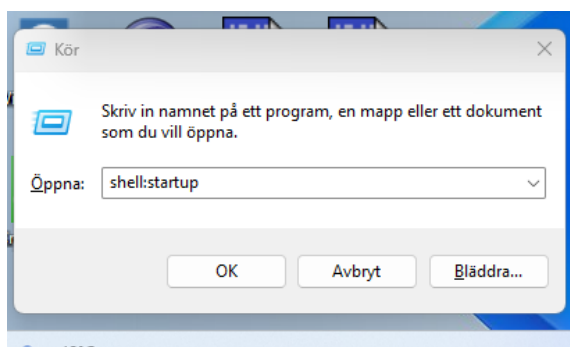


Configure Windows to automatically launch Chrome when you start your computer in Kiosk mode

- 1) Connect keyboard and mouse to simplify entering of data.
- 2) Right-click on the Chrome icon on your desktop and select "Rename", name the icon to e.g. "Timestamp"
- 3) Right-click on the Chrome icon and select "Properties"
- 4) Finally, in the "Target" field, add "--kiosk" (NOTE: a space between " and --k) + the URL to your web clock that you received from your T&A system (i.e. replace www.dn.se below)
- 5) Tryck "OK"

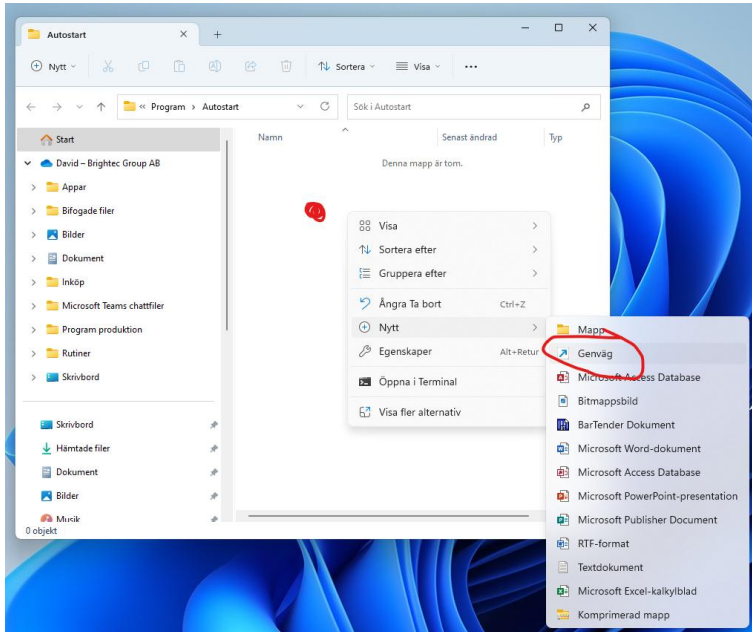


- 6) Klick the Windows key on your keyboard
- 7) Type "RUN" (without the quotes) and klick Enter (on your keyboard)
- 8) In the "Open" field, type "Shell:startup" (without the quotes)

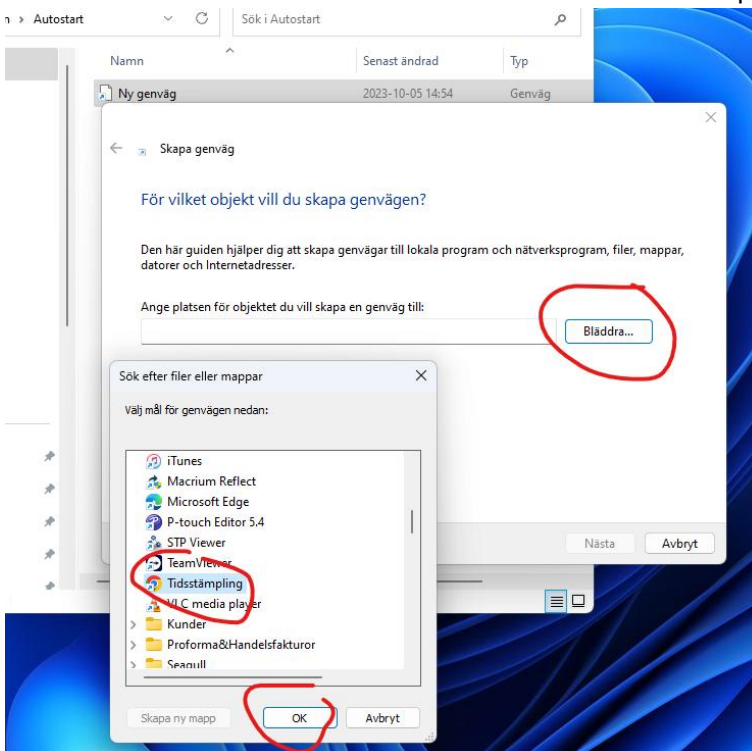


- 9) Klick "OK"
- 10) The "Autostart" folder will now open

11) Right-click where the red dot is highlighted in the image below and select “New->Shortcut”

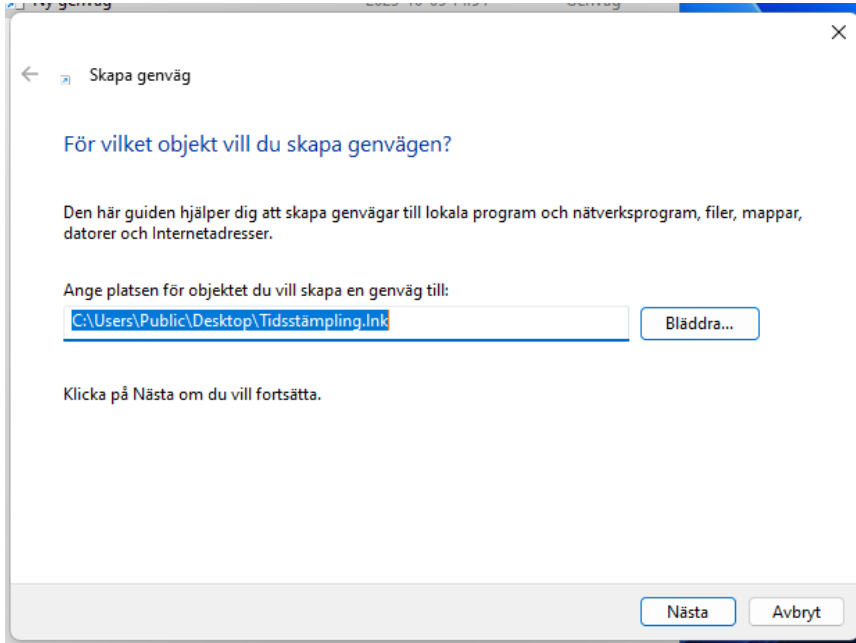


12) Klick “Browse” and select the Chrome icon named “Timestamp”

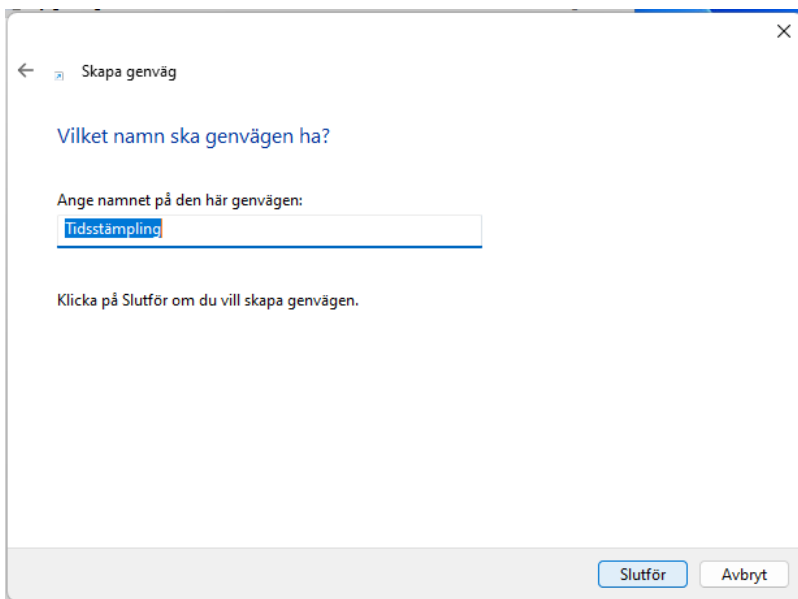


13) Klick "OK"

14) Klick "Next"



15) Klick "Finish"



Now you've finished

Test by restarting your computer. Chrome should now automatically start with your Time tracking page in Kiosk mode

To get out of Kiosk mode, plug in a keyboard and press ALT+F4
